ECO-SUSTAINABLE TOURISM

Our company, with a view to improving the efficiency of the environmental and energy management system, has planned a series of structural interventions. Help us with our project with small tricks that are essential in the success of the path to environmental protection:

- · We change towels daily; throw on the floor only those you want replaced;
- The set of disposable soaps has been replaced with dispensers in order to reduce waste volume, minimize product waste, and prevent their dispersion into the environment:
- Remember to turn off unnecessary lights: efficient use of available lighting helps to significantly reduce electricity consumption;
- While brushing your teeth or shampooing, turn off the faucet when water is not needed;
- Our Hotels support a separate waste collection campaign, help us by using the appropriate colored bags for each type of waste (blue for plastic and white for paper);
- Always close room windows if the heating and/or air conditioning system is running; Remember to always turn off electrical devices before falling asleep;
- Set the indoor temperature based on your needs, using the appropriate controllers; remember that the temperatures to ensure physiological well-being in the rooms should be around 20°C in the winter period and 6°-7°C lower than outside (however, no higher than 26°C) in the summer period;
- Report to us any inefficiencies (leaks, malfunctions, etc.); Recommend other useful measures for the protection of the environment and contribute to our campaign.

RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT CAN CONTINUE OUTSIDE OUR HOTELS

- Buy local food and drinks, even something as simple as a bottle of water. Transporting goods causes significant pollution in terms of emissions and resource use.
- Bring a reusable water bottle, Rome is full of drinking fountains where you can fill it with fresh water, helping you avoid the use of plastic bottles.
- Use the recycling bins available throughout the city and support our waste separation campaign.
- Check for public transportation options when planning your visit to a specific area.
- Choose eco-friendly ways to explore the city, for example, rent a bicycle at one of the dedicated rental points to visit the historic center.
- Share your eco-tourism experiences with other guests and leave us your suggestions on our social networks.
